This year we have bought an additional treadmill and replaced our leaking water rower with a new Concept 2 rower. If you came to the New Victory Hall celebrations in September you will have seen the new rower and our instructor Gary in the gym's rowing challenge. We are currently raising money to buy a recumbent bike to replace one of our upright bikes. Recumbent bikes are easier to get on and off and place less strain on muscles and joints than the upright bikes.
